Come one, come all and bring your treasures with you! If you have ever wondered about the history or value of your favorite antique or family heirloom, bring it to ASHM on September 10th for our Antique Appraisal Day with general appraiser Robert Borgstrom.

Mr. Borgstrom is a certified personal property appraiser and antiques broker who operates under the d/b/a of Rose Valley Antiques & Appraisals, LLC and has been involved in the appraising and brokering of antiques for the last 20+

years. He currently is calling auctions weekly at Briggs Auction in Garnet Valley, PA and auctions monthly at Uniques & Antiques in Aston, PA. Certified with a GPPA (Graduate Personal Property Appraiser) through the Auction Marketing Institute and the CAGA (Certified Appraisers Guild of America) designation, Robert C. Borgstrom has conducted over 500 personal property appraisals and has called more than 1,000 public auctions.

Appraisals will be given on a first-come first-serve basis for up to three items per person. Each person with items will be given a number upon arrival. Guests may sit in the audience while each number is called and appraisals given live in front of the group.
