

ASHM December Toddler Time: Tiptoe with Tomte


About Swedish Tomten

Tomte Song:


Hi, Tomtegubbar

Play Dough Recipe

1 cup flour
½ cup salt
2 teaspoons cream of tartar
1 tablespoon oil
1 cup water
2 teaspoons cinnamon
2 teaspoons ginger
2 teaspoons ground cloves

Directions:

1. Mix everything in a pot and put over medium heat on the stove.
2. Stir until dough forms.
3. Let the dough cool, then it is time to play!
4. Store in an airtight container.
