

# Lion Face Craft

Today we are making a lion to go with our book "The Lion's Paw".  
Materials needed and instructions are listed below.

## Materials

- ✓ Small Paper Plate
- ✓ Colored construction Paper
- ✓ Googly Eyes
- ✓ Markers or Crayons
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Scissors



## Directions:

1. First cut the construction paper into inch wide strips that will be our mane, you want use at least 2 colors.
2. Cut a corner off a piece of black paper to make the nose.

3. Next you want to color the plate with markers or crayons. Make sure you cover the inner part the sides don't have to be completely covered.



2. Then glue one end of the paper strip to the side of the plate. You want to alternate colors all around the plate.



3. Then glue the eyes and nose in the middle of the plate. If you don't have googly eyes you can draw some eyes in the next step.



4. Next using a black marker or crayon draw on mouth and whiskers of your lion.



5. Lastly, we want to curl our lion's mane. Take a pencil, thin marker or crayon and roll the outside end of paper onto it. Hold for a few seconds, then let go.



Now you have a beautiful curly maned lion!
