with snowflake crafts and activities.

Snowflake Matching Game

Materials:

- ✓ Different snowflake sheet
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Markers or crayons

Directions:

1. Cut out the different snowflake cards.
2. Decorate cards with markers or crayons.
3. Flip all the snowflakes over back side up.
4. Take turns flipping over two cards at a time to match the snowflakes.
5. Winner has the most matches at the end.

Dress Treva Paper Doll

Materials:

- ✓ Plank Doll Form sheet
- ✓ Clothing pieces sheet
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Markers or crayons

Directions:

1. Decorate clothing with markers or crayons.
2. Cut the clothing pieces out of the paper.
3. Glue the clothing pieces onto the doll, matching where the hat, mittens, boots go on the doll.
4. Finish doll by drawing a face, hair, etc.

Snowflake Puzzle Craft

Materials:

- ✓ Background paper square
- ✓ 3 rectangle pieces of white paper
- ✓ Assortment of smaller cut paper pieces
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Markers or crayons



Directions:

1. Glue one rectangle piece in the center of the background making a vertical line.



2. Glue the other two pieces making and X across the first piece.



3. Next glue the small pieces along the arms of the snowflake making a pattern of points on the snowflake.



4. Decorate with markers or crayons. Write your name on the background piece.
