Space under the tent is first come first serve, and any vendors exceeding the space will be placed on the lawn side of the terrace but may provide their own 10x10 pop-up tent. Spaces in both areas are limited.

#### Vendor Event Regulations

1. Set-up is Saturday, July 14th from 9am-11:30 am. Vendors must be ready by 11:30 a.m.
2. ASHM is not responsible for vendor merchandise at any time in any location.
3. Vendors must remain open until the event close at 4 p.m. Breakdown will be from 4-6pm.
4. Items for sale must be within the hemslöjd/handmade tradition event theme. ASHM reserves the right to decline vendor applications whose merchandise is duplicative of other vendors and/or does not fit the theme.
5. Each vendor will be provided one 6ft table and two chairs for use. Vendors must provide their own pop-up tent and table cloths if preferred.
6. Free WiFi is available for use. Vendors who choose to take credit card payment must provide their own credit card processing software and devices.

Vendors must register by 6/30/2024. Payment is due with application submission. Spaces are limited and will be filled on a first paid basis. Each vendor lot size is 8'x8'. Additional lots may be purchased if needed. ASHM is located at 1900 Pattison Ave., Philadelphia, PA 19145.
